

VOLUNTEER INFORMATION

Dear Volunteer,

Thank you very much for volunteering to help with the 2009 Cal Ripken 12-Year Old World Series. This is going to be a very special event and we couldn't do it without your help! We are extremely grateful that you are willing to give your time to this event and we humbly ask you to read all of the information below (which we've tried to keep as brief as possible). If you have any further questions, please let us know.

If for some reason you cannot make your shift, please make every possible effort to find a replacement and contact me only if, despite your efforts, we will be left with an open position.

Shirts and Badges

- Volunteers will be given shirts and name badges to wear at the field.
- Please let us know if the name on your badge should be different than the name that you see on the schedule. This is especially important for any students that are entered under their parent's accounts.
- Shirts and badges can be picked up on Wednesday, August 12 from 9:30am – Noon at the volunteer check-in station at the entrance to Nutile Field on Wildwood Street OR when you check in for your shift.

Parking (for Volunteers)

- If possible, we encourage you to walk, ride your bike or carpool.
- Limited volunteer parking will be available at the far, far left (or south) side of the Mahoney's parking lot. (To the left of the building where the Christmas decorations are sold.)
- If the volunteer parking area at Mahoney's is full, you will be directed to another lot.
- Please do not park in the volunteer lot at Mahoney's if you plan to remain at Nutile Field longer than your shift to enjoy the games. Your courtesy in this regard will allow the next round of volunteers to use the spaces at Mahoney's.

Arrival and Check-in

- You will check in at the ticket booth near the entrance to Nutile Field on Wildwood Street. The ticket booth will have a list of volunteers for the day. If your name is on the list, you will have free admission to the field. If you have not already received your shirt and badge, you will be given them at that time.
- Once inside Nutile Field, please go to your meeting point (see below) and check in with the staff located there. A staff coordinator or other volunteer will provide you with a review of how to fulfill your role.
- Parking volunteers – you may be notified in advance of your location, in which case please go directly to that site.
